WHO CAN ENTER?

- Preteens, age 12 and under
- Juniors, age 13-16
- Seniors, age 17-24
- Adults, age 25 and older

Age as of December 31 of competition year

- Made for Others (any age)
- Wearable Accessory

You must participate in the state where you live or attend school

Anyone regardless of race, creed, or sex who meets age requirements and other guidelines may participate.

Preteen, junior, senior, and adult contestants must select, construct and model their own garments.

Made for Others entries: the intended wearer must model garments.

WHAT CAN I ENTER?

Preteens may enter:

• Dress, jumper, skirt, pants, shorts, vest, sweater, shirt/blouse, jacket, or a combination of garments.

Junior, Senior, Adult, Made for Others may enter:

- **ONE PIECE GARMENT:** dress, jumper, outerwear jacket, coat or cape.
- **Two piece outfit:** coat, jacket, cape, blouse/shirt, vest or sweater <u>with</u> dress, jumper, skirt, pants or shorts.
- Ensemble (<u>3 or more garments worn</u> together at one time): Coat, jacket, cape, blouse/shirt, vest, and/or sweater with dress, jumper, skirt, pants or shorts

To be eligible, a garment must have been completed after January 1, 2012

WHAT ARE THE JUDGING CRITERIA?

- Appropriateness to contestant's lifestyle
- Coordination of fabric/yarn with garment style and design
- Contestant's presentation
- Creativity

Judging is private and decisions are final

Fashion Design Competition

- Be currently enrolled in a college-level fashion or apparel design program
- Be at least 17 years old
- Create an original design
- Construct a garment for self or for another
- Follow rules for the established "Make It With Wool" competition

Winners won't be eligible to compete again for 3 yrs. Cannot also be the State winner-must choose Provide transportation for his/her model if needed Promotional trips at the discretion of NMIWW/ASIW
